please observe the following to protect yourself and others.



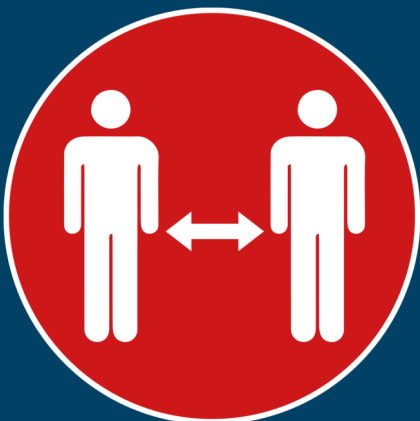
Wear a face covering

- Please wear a face covering when you are moving around the hospital building, for example during examinations or outpatient procedures.
- Wear a face covering in your room when staff or visitors are present.
- Always use a face covering when you leave your room and are in the waiting areas or in the courtyard.



Regularly disinfect your hands

- when entering/leaving the patient room or examination room,
- after contact with mucous membranes (blowing your nose) or after using the facilities (toilet | after washing and drying your hands),
- after contact with medical devices, medicine packages, etc.



Keep a safe distance

Keep a distance of 1.5 m between yourself and others when you are in the hospital. This applies particularly when you leave your room for examinations or treatments.

The cafeteria and other services are closed and cannot be used. You are also not permitted to leave the hospital grounds.

Do not enter any other wards and do not leave the hospital grounds.
